## Guidelines for pregnant women working with chemicals in the clean room

Pregnant women (or those who are planning pregnancy) should carefully read the material safety data sheet (MSDS) and be aware of its special risks.

- 1. If section 2 in the MSDS indicates that the material "May damage fertility or the unborn child", in that case you may find a replacement employee for the procedure. Sometimes only the powder form is risky, you may consult us.
- 2. If replacement is not possible, take extra care:
  - 2.1 Work with double gloves
  - 2.2 Wear mask (depending on the risk)
  - 2.3 work only in a fume hood
  - 2.4 Package waste (solid or liquid) only inside the fume hood.
- 3. If you intend to use syringes, a blunt end needle should be used to prevent needle stick. They come in nine different sizes, you can find cat number in the safety web site, or contact us.
- 4. You can always contact us to evaluate the risk.
